VISITATION GUIDELINES

Family Education Program 12:00 – 1:00 PM Sat/Sun – Visitation & family counseling 1:00 – 3:00 PM Sat/Sun Male units' visitation – SatFemale unit visitation – Sun

- 1. All visitors must receive prior approval from the treatment team.
- 2. Visitors under the age of 18 years are NOT permitted in the facility unless prearranged with the primary counselor or family coordinator to participate in staff-supervised family counseling.
- 3. Children may not be left in vehicles or on Shoreline property unattended.
- 4. Clients must visit with parents or visitors inside the facility.
- 5. Visitors must have a driver's license or other valid form of identification.
- 6. No more than five visitors per client are allowed unless prior arrangements are made with the clinical team.
- 7. Visitors are limited to immediate family members unless prior arrangements have been made with the clinical treatment team.
- 8. Visitors may not enter client living areas.
- 9. Smoking is NOT permitted. No tobacco in any form (or tobacco-like products including e-cigarettes) is allowed in the facility or facility grounds. Smoking is permitted in private vehicles <u>only</u>. Cigarettes butts shall not be disposed of on facility grounds.
- 10. Visitors may not give clients tobacco. It is illegal for a minor to possess tobacco or tobacco products.
- 11. Food or beverages shall not be brought into the facility.
- 12. Visitors may not give clients money. Clients may not have money in their possession.
- 13. At time of arrival, all client property must be given directly to staff on duty for proper processing.
- 14. Cameras, including cell phones with cameras, are not permitted. Photographs may not be taken on Shoreline's property.
- 15. No electronic or recordable devices allowed including cell phones, laptops, game boys, IPods, Kindles, IPads, etc.
- 16. Firearms are prohibited.
- 17. Illegal drugs and alcohol are prohibited.
- 18. Appropriate clothing is required. No bare feet, sagging, tight, form-fitting, or exposing clothing is allowed.
- 19. Inappropriate language or behavior is not tolerated. This includes profanity, hand-gestures, verbal or physical aggression.
- 20. Shoreline reserves the right to terminate visitation for failure to adhere to the guidelines of these guidelines.
